Youth focused on setting up and tearing down the equipment being used for the final event. The week closed with the youth presenting their skills and practices at the 20th Anniversary event!





Youth concluded the program on Friday, August 9th. The youth showcased their talents and what they learned at the ceremony!






WEEK AHEAD
